## "I AM THANKFUL FOR THE CHURCH OF CHRIST" BY: JASON GANN

I am so thankful for the church of Christ, which belongs to Christ, that Christ built almost 2,000 years ago. It is within the church that salvation is found (Acts 2:47). Acts 2:47 says, "Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved."

If you are not a Christian, I encourage you to hear the Word of God, believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, repent of sins, confess that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins. Upon your baptism, you will be a Christian, and then you must live faithfully unto death. This is what the Plan of Salvation says.

Let us look at each point in the Plan of Salvation. You need to hear the Word of God (Romans 10:17). Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." You need to believe the Gospel that Jesus Christ is the Son of God (Mark 16:16). Mark 16:16 says, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." You need to repent of past sins (II Peter 3:9). II Peter 3:9 says, "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." You need to confess that Jesus is the Son of God (Matthew 10:32). Matthew 10:32 says, "Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven." You need to be baptized for the forgiveness of your sins (Acts 2:38). Acts 2:38 says, "Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Upon your baptism, you will be a Christian, a member of the Lord's church, and you must live faithfully unto death (Revelation 2:10). Revelation 2:10 says, ". . . be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life." If you are not a Christian and you want to become one, please let me know.

If you go astray as a Christian, you should repent and confess your sins, then through prayer, forgiveness will be extended. You can be forgiven even though you are an unfaithful Christian. This is what the Second Law of Pardon says.

Let us look at each point of the Second Law of Pardon. An unfaithful Christian needs to repent (Acts 8:22). Acts 8:22 says, "Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee." An unfaithful Christian needs to confess sins (I John 1:9). I John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Through prayer, an unfaithful Christian can then be restored as we saw in Acts 8:22. If you are a Christian who has gone astray and you want to make your life right, please let me know.

I want to help all that I can to go to Heaven. I hope you do, also. I encourage you to make sure that you are a Christian, living faithfully devoted to God each day!
