When we are faithful, we are living like God for He is Faithful (II Thessalonians 3:3). When awe are living faithfully, we will be living in a holy way (I Peter 1:16). We will not be conformed to the sins of the world, but rather will be transformed by the renewing of our mind through the study of the Word of God (Romans 12:2). Sin is the transgression of the law of God (I John 3:4). Those who do not keep God's Word are not living faithfully. No sin will enter Heaven (Revelation 21:27), yet those who are living faithfully will enter there.

Hearing (Romans 10:17), believing (Mark 16:16), repenting (Acts 2:38), confessing (Matthew 10:32), and being baptized (Acts 2:38) are all necessary to be faithful, but upon one's baptism a person becomes a Christian, then must work to remain faithful. Revelation 22:14 says, "Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city." Let us living in such a way as to have Heaven in the end!

“REMAIN FAITHFUL” BY: JASON GANN

Christ says in Revelation 2:10, “Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.” While this verse was first said to the church in Smyrna in the First Century, the principle of being faithful unto death to receive a crown of life is for all Christians. Faithfulness is important.

Faithfulness has always been important. Under the Old Law, we are told of the man named Moses. Numbers 12:7 says, “My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house.” Moses was faithful. He chose rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season (Hebrews 11:25). Psalm 31:23 tells us, “O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.”

Under the New Law, which we are under now (Colossians 2:14), we are told to walk in the footsteps of Christ. I Peter 2:21 says, “For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:”. Verses 22 and 23 tell us about Christ, “Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:”. Christ is the Perfect Example of faithfulness.

Christ exemplifies Perfection as a human being and also as the Son of God. He taught in the Parable of Talents that unto those who used their talents, that these were “good and faithful” servants. These were rewarded with joy, while the one who did not use his talents was cast away into outer darkness (Matthew 25:14-30). The same will happen to the unfaithful on the Judgment Day (Matthew 25:31-46).

We are commanded to be faithful in Revelation 2:10 and in I Corinthians 4:1-2. In I Corinthians 4:1-2, we are told, “Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.” Through being faithful, we have all spiritual blessings in Christ (Ephesians 1:1-3). We know that continued obedience is necessary to be pleasing to God and to go to Heaven (Hebrews 5:9, II Thessalonians 1:7-10).

Being faithful means that we are putting God First in all things (Matthew 6:33). This means that we are praying without ceasing (I Thessalonians 5:17), and we are meditating upon God’s Word day and night (II Timothy 2:15, Psalm 1). Being faithful means that we assemble with the Saints without forsaking the assembling (Hebrews 10:25). Being faithful means being of service to help others (Matthew 5:41, 7:21). Being faithful means spreading the Gospel (Matthew 28:18-20, II Timothy 2:2). We must abound or “overflow” in good works to be faithful (II Peter 1:5-11).
