# “WHEN GOD DECIDES ENOUGH IS ENOUGH: PART 2” BY: ROGER CAMPBELL

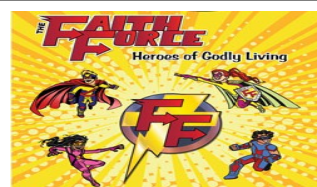
When it became clear that Judah was not budging from her path of self-willed rebellion against Jehovah, there was only one way the situation would end. The Bible text first points to God’s *compassion* (2 Chron. 36:15), then another aspect of His character is revealed in the very next verse —“*the wrath of the LORD arose against His people.*” Read again the tragic words which follow that statement: “*till there was no remedy.*” When Judah turned away from the Lord’s instructions, they were turning away from the only remedy! He alone was the Physician with the “balm of Gilead” to heal Judah’s spiritual sickness. God was basically saying, “Fine, if you do not want my balm/remedy, then you will face the consequences.”

In the end, God decided that “enough is enough” and raised up Nebuchadnezzar to punish His stiff-necked people. *(Note: Continued on Page 4)*
