

“ANY SIN”

I John 5:17 tells us that, “All unrighteousness is sin”. I John 3:4 teaches, “Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.” Sin separates us from God. We cannot sin and still be pleasing in His sight. The literal meaning of the word sin is “to miss the mark.” When we sin, we have missed the mark of obeying God. We cannot sin and go to Heaven. Isaiah 59:2 says, “But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.” Sin, any sin, separates us from God. Revelation 22:15 says about Heaven there is no sin found therein, for “For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.” Those who do not walk in the Light as God is in the Light, will be cast away into eternal punishment, Matthew 25:46, while the righteous shall go into life eternal. II Thessalonians 1:7-10 says, “And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.”
