“PEACE AND LOVE” BY: JASON GANN

Peace and love. Two special words representing two components of the Christian’s life. These are two qualities that we all want in our lives. Thanks be to God for giving unto His people, peace and love! Truly, we, as Christians, have that more abundant life of which Christ spoke in John 10:10 when He said, “The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.”

We have so many blessings in Christ, which make our lives here truly abundant and successful. Some of these include the forgiveness of sins, Ephesians 1:7; the hope of Heaven, Titus 1:2; having Jesus and the Holy Spirit as our Intercessors, Romans 8:26 and 34; having God living within us, II Corinthians 6:16; having spiritual brothers and sisters along with their fellowship, I John 1:7; the ability to pray to God and have our prayers heard, I Peter 3:12; and Heaven in the end, Ephesians 1:11.

As Christians, we also have peace and love. You see, God through Paul says in Ephesians 6:23, “Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.” Let’s examine three phrases from this sentence.

PEACE BE TO THE BRETHREN. This is what should be among brothers and sisters in Christ, that is, peace. I Peter 3:11 says, “Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.” Romans 12:18 says, “If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.” This not peace at any cost. This is not peace through compromising God’s Word, for we can never add to, nor take from it (Revelation 22:18-19). This is peace that characterizes a child of God’s life, when he follows what we call the “Golden Rule” as Christ taught in Matthew 7:12. II Timothy 2:24-26 teaches us to not strive, but to be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves.

LOVE WITH FAITH BE TO THE BRETHREN. Love includes peace and results from faith. Faith comes through hearing and obedience to the Word of God (Romans 10:17, Hebrews 5:9). I John 3:16 says, “Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.” We ought to love our brethren so much that we would lay down our lives for our brothers in Christ if the occasion called for it.

PEACE AND LOVE WITH FAITH COME FROM THE FATHER AND HIS SON. Calm hearts result in a church at peace. *(Note: Continued on Page 4)*
