Then, there is the need to live faithfully unto death (Revelation 2:10). This is where the imitating Paul comes in here. In living faithfully, we must follow the example of Paul. When we stumble, we must repent (Acts 8:22), confess sins (I John 1:9), and through prayer have forgiveness (Acts 8:22).

As Paul encouraged the Christians in days gone by to follow him, so must we follow his example. This following of Paul’s example goes so far as to extent of which he follows Christ (I Corinthians 11:1). We are so thankful for this great example to follow and our Ultimate Example, Christ (I Peter 2:21-25).

Now, having said these things, let me ask you. Are you living in such a way as to where you could say, “Be imitators of me?” Can people imitate you, and still be faithful unto God? How would they be if they did imitate you? Romans 14:13 says, “Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.” Let us let our light shine so that people will glorify our God (Matthew 5:16). Let us live in a way as to where people can imitate us and still find Heaven as their home in the end.
