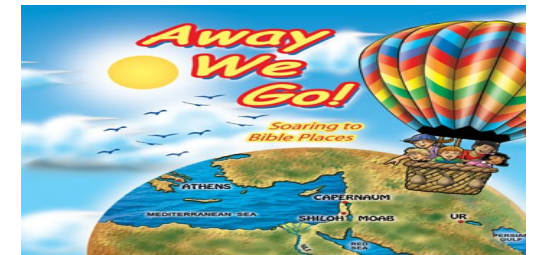
Vacation Bible School 2016
