“A WILLINGNESS TO FORGIVE”

When Christ gave the “Model Prayer” in Matthew Chapter 6, verses 9 through 11, He says, “After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.” After teaching the disciples how to pray. He then says, “For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.” We must be willing to forgive in this Christian life. This word for “forgive” means to “to let go, give up, a debt.” If we fail to forgive others, then God will not forgive us. In our effort to live a spiritually successful life, we must be willing to forgive and to be forgiven. A true mark of Christianity is the willingness to forgive. Another true mark of Christianity is the willingness to be forgiven.

Now in understanding the importance of forgiveness, let us remember that God only forgives those who repent, and likewise, we can only forgive those who repent. In Luke 17:3, Christ says, “Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him.” Notice, there, “if” your brother sins again you, then you rebuke. Notice, the second part of this statement. Notice again, “if” he repent, forgive him. Forgive him if he repents. What about those who sin against us repeatedly and legitimately repent repeatedly, must we still forgive them or draw the line and say our mercy ends on the fortieth time? Do we say three strikes and you are out when it comes to our forgiveness? The answer is no! We must forgive, forgive, forgive, forgive, forgive, forgive, and then forgive some more, brothers and sisters! Our forgiving spirit never goes from us! We never stop forgiving! Never means never! We never stop forgiving!

You see, Christ continues in Luke 17:4, by stating, “And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him.” The number “seven” in the Bible stands for completion and perfection. This means that as many times as our brother asks for forgiveness, we are to forgive him, even if he asked for it seven times in the same day. It is very rare that we have someone who apologizes so much. In fact, in today’s day and time, it seems that some are unwilling to offer the first apology.
