## “THE BIBLE IS NOT OPTIONAL: PART 1”

There are many great books authored by men. While these books contribute to man’s education, it is not mandatory that a person read and study all of them. One book, however, is unique from all others. It is the Holy Bible. It is this book that cannot be neglected without eternal consequences.

The Bible Must be Read and Studied. One will never benefit from the Holy Scriptures if he does not read them or have them read to him. The Lord indicted those of His day for not knowing or not practicing the demands of the Scriptures. When the Pharisees made false accusations against His disciples, Jesus said, “*Have ye not read what David did*” (Matt. 12:3) and “*Have ye not read in the law*” (Matt. 12:5)? When the chief priests and elders demanded “by what authority” Jesus did the things He did, the Lord said, “*Did ye never read in the scriptures*” (Matt. 21:42)? It is easy to discern that Christ intended for people to read and study the Bible. And, God’s Word can be understood! The Scriptures admonish, “*Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is*” (Eph. 5:17). It is true that people will be lost because of “*a lack of knowledge*” (Hosea 4:6).

The Bible Must be Believed! There are many who do not read the Bible. Something even more tragic, however, is the number of people who do read the Bible, but do not believe it. The reason is because of preconceived ideals, bias, prejudice, or simply not wanting to accept the truth. The Scriptures assert that “*faith (belief) cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God*” (Rom. 10:17). Only through the word of God is Biblical faith possible, and the Holy Word has been given to us to produce belief. The apostle John recorded, “*And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name*” (John 20:30-31). It is true today even as the writer of Hebrews says, “*For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it*” (Heb. 4:2).

The Bible Must be Obeyed! All mankind will either be lost in hell or saved in heaven, and the Bible is the book by which people will be judged. Christ warns, “*He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day*” (John 12:48).
