"BE OF GOOD CHEER" BY: CHARLES POGUE

John records these words of Jesus to His disciples in John 16:32-33:

Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. These things have I spoken unto you, that in me ye may have peace. In the world ye have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Both Matthew and Mark record the disciples fled in fear when Judas led the officers out to arrest the Lord (Mat. 26:56; Mark 14:50). Despite those men fleeing, Jesus was not alone. As He told them, "the Father is with me."

In this life, the children of the Father are often forsaken by loved ones and friends. Let us not be downcast, however. If we are faithful to the Father, He will be with us. Christ will be with us, and we can face whatever difficulties come our way, and we all know those are diverse and many. Let us remember as the wise man wrote: "A glad heart maketh a cheerful countenance; But by sorrow of heart the spirit is broken" (Pro. 15:13). As we would say, regardless of what comes your way, "Keep your chin up." We all need to be reminded of that from time to time, do we not?

There is one indisputable reason why the child of God should not be so downcast that peace of mind is lost. The reason is stated well by Matthew 9:1-2:

And he entered into a boat, and crossed over, and came into his own city. And behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, be of good cheer; thy sins are forgiven.

The forgiveness of sins is inseparable from salvation. When Paul spoke to king Agrippa, he described to him the mission the Lord revealed Paul would have. Among Paul's words, in Acts 26, to Agrippa are the ones from verse 18:

to open their eyes, that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive remission of sins and an inheritance among them that are sanctified by faith in me

We are familiar with chapter 22 of verse 16, Ananias came to Paul (then known as Saul) and told him to arise and be baptized and have his sins washed away. We know, then, those who have their sins washed away in baptism are those who receive forgiveness of sins as stated in Acts 26:18. We also know, those who obey God in such a way, and are faithful to Him, have the promise of the inheritance Paul spoke about to Agrippa in that verse.
