"THE CHURCH YOU READ ABOUT IN THE BIBLE: PART 1" BY: JIM LAWS

There has been so much discussion about the church these days. It has been and continues to be a topic which many write about. To some it is nothing more than a human organization which we are free to change at will. To others it is a type of social club to join. Many see no real connection between the church of the New Testament and the all important matter of salvation.

First, let's consider what the Bible means by "church." When we speak of the church of the New Testament, we do not refer to a building in which we meet for worship. Someone says immediately, "Yes, I have known that even as a child." Perhaps this is true, but I think that we need to be reminded of it again and again. The word church originally comes from the word ekklesia, which in essence means "the called out." Those who have been obedient to the gospel of Christ are the called out ones (2 Cor. 6:14-18). When we speak of the church of the New Testament, we are speaking of people—people who have heard the Word of God and have grown to sufficient faith in Him that they have submissively given their lives to Him. The church is a living building, a spiritual one built of living stones (1 Pet. 2:5).
