## “FOLLOWER OF CHRIST”

The word “Christian” means a “Follower of Christ.” We must walk in His footsteps. I Peter Chapter 2, verses 21 through 24 say, “For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: [Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.” Jesus has provided us the perfect example that we should follow in His steps. Verse 25 goes on to say, “For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.” Christ is our Chief Shepherd. We are His sheep. As such, we must follow Him in all ways. We are on safe ground when we walk in His footsteps.

It is like when we walk in the snow. When tracks are left in the snow. It is cold outside. Let’s say the temperature does not go above freezing. We look back at those footsteps. We might need to go back outside again. The safest places to walk are found within those tracks within those footsteps. The other areas are slick, and in them, we might fall, but within the footsteps left in the snow, we find safety. We experienced weather like this a few days ago. We know how slick it can get in the snow from then and times past. Now, it is the case, that it is now always snowy on the ground, but even when the snow is not on the ground and even when it is, we must walk in the footsteps of Jesus in everything that we do. In fact, we ought to live in such a way that we can say as the Apostle Paul said in I Corinthians 11:1, “Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.”

The happiest life is the Christian life. It is a life of not worrying. It is a life of letting go of guilt and worry, and letting God take care of those things. I Peter 5:7 says about Christ, “Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.” It is a life of hope, the hope of Heaven, Titus 1:2. We live “In hope of eternal life”. Heaven will be given to us in the end. Revelation 22:14 says, ‘Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.’
