“THE CHURCH LIBRARY”

If Timothy 2:15 says, “Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.” In our efforts to live the faithful Christian life, which we are commanded to live in Revelation 2:10, it is so important that we engage ourselves in study. Our faith is increased the more we imbibe the Holy Scriptures with an open heart (Romans 10:17) for God’s Word says, “So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God). We understand as James 2:10 directs that, “For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.” The issue of study then is an important one, because if we are to remain faithful, we must study God’s Word. We proclaim that the study of the Holy Bible should be of utmost importance to us. Meditation on God’s Word should be our focus both day and night (Psalm 1:2-3). We should never let a day or night go by without meditating on His Word.

We can understand God’s Word by our individual study of it (Ephesians 3:4), but certainly, having the aid of others can help us to understand God’s Word. We can certainly learn from each other, no matter how much study we might do. Preachers and teachers do much work in helping people understand God’s Word through much study. In Nehemiah 8:8, we see examples of those who helped others understand God’s Word by interpreting it correctly. Here we read, “So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading.” In Acts 11:4, we see Peter doing the same thing by “expounding” God’s Word. We are thankful to have at the Campaign church of Christ building a library that belongs to the congregation. Within our library, we have many books written by people who will help us in our Bible study.

Recently, our library was organized based on topics and the books were placed on the large bookshelf that we have in an orderly fashion. A list of these books were compiled with information about the titles of these books, their authors, and their topics. Copies of this list were handed out to the members last Sunday, and the “Campaign church of Christ Library List” is located in a black binder in the office for people to view, also. You are encouraged to take advantage of the opportunity to have these books within your reach. We have 153 books in our library. We also have DVDs in the library, which were included in the DVD portion of the list. At the top of the list is the Book from God, the Holy Bible. Below the Holy Bible are other books that can help us to understand the Bible. We have general study books, ladies’ study books, children’s study books, workbooks, and DVDs. These are the categories of books on the different shelves.

If you have books that you would like to add to the church library, you may do so. If you would like to donate any books in memory of precious loved ones, please do so. We hope that our library will continue to grow. We have books for all ages. You are encouraged to check out books and DVDs from the library. It belongs to you. You do not have to fill out anything to check these out as these belong to you. Go back to the office anytime, and check out any book and/or DVD you want. When you are finished with them, place them on the desk, and they will be put back on the bookshelf for you. It is as easy as this!
