“THE WICKED SHALL NOT PROSPER FOREVER”

Brethren, let us ever know that God is at work in His providence to ensure that the wicked do not prosper forever. God may allow someone to do us wrongly, for example, for a time, but they are not allowed to do this forever. It should not be surprising then that Proverbs 24:19-20 says, “Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked; For there shall be no reward to the evil man; the candle of the wicked shall be put out.” Psalm 37:1-2 says, “Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity. For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.” Matthew 23:12 says, “And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.” Doing evil causes us to reap evil, but doing good causes us to reap good.

Jeremiah asked a question about the wicked prospering in Chapter 12, verse 1 and perhaps we may have thought at sometime in our past that the wicked prosper, but never let us think that they will be allowed to prosper forever, Jeremiah found this out. In verse 1, he says, “Righteous art thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: yet let me talk with thee of thy judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? wherefore are all they happy that deal very treacherously?” Then he finds out what will happen to the wicked and what will happen to them sure is not prosperity as God reveals to him in verses 13 through 14, “They have sown wheat, but shall reap thorns: they have put themselves to pain, but shall not profit: and they shall be ashamed of your revenues because of the fierce anger of the LORD. Thus saith the LORD against all mine evil neighbours, that touch the inheritance which I have caused my people Israel to inherit; Behold, I will pluck them out of their land, and pluck out the house of Judah from among them.” A wicked one may appear to be prosperous, but it may be the case that this one is not really happy at all. God’s providence involves Him working to cause specific bad people to reap what they sow and this principle should be a deterrent for us to cause us not to want to live wickedly.

True happiness comes from serving Christ. We have so many blessings in Christ, which make our lives here truly abundant and successful. Some of these include the forgiveness of sins, Ephesians 1:7; the hope of Heaven, Titus 1:2; having Jesus and the Holy Spirit as our Intercessors, Romans 8:26 and 34; having God living within us, II Corinthians 6:16; having spiritual brothers and sisters along with their fellowship, I John 1:7; the ability to pray to God and have our prayers heard, I Peter 3:12; and Heaven in the end, Ephesians 1:11. Come to Jesus! He will bear your burdens! He will make your life truly prosperous! This prosperity will not be fleeting. This will be lasting! It will be true happiness here and eternal happiness in Heaven!
