



At times, we will hear politicians speak about the need to be on the right side of history. By this, they mean that we do not want people in future times to look back on us and the positions that we have taken, and say that we were on the wrong side of history. It is so true that we need to make sure that if this world continues beyond our time here that people look back and judge with righteous judgment that we were on the right side of history. Friends, it is important that people who are living now look at us and see that we are on the right side of history for history is being made every second.

The Hebrews' penman speaks about the great cloud of witnesses of those who had gone on to Paradise, who lived such faithful lives for whom the world was not worthy in Hebrews 11 and 12. These give us great encouragement that we can serve God, also, and stand strong just as they did despite all of the things for which they went through in life. Hebrews 11:33-38 says about these, "Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. Hebrews 11:4 says of him, "By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh."
