"THE FAMILY" BY: HARDEMAN NICHOLS

"Except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it (Psalm 127:1).

You have observed families who are able to come unscathed through trying times; who bear up under all sorts of trials and difficulties without disintegrating. What are their sources of strength?

A few years ago, an Oklahoma State University research team carefully looked into the patterns and habits of each person in 99 successful families. Six characteristics were found to be common bonds peculiar to all these families.

1. Much time together.

They took a lot of time for all the family to be together. These were pleasant times that both children and parents enjoyed.

2. Good listeners.

They knew how to hear what the others were saying. They were easy to talk to. And they avoided criticizing and complaining.

3. Strong commitment to family.

They believed their family was more important than personal preferences, each willingly sacrificing to see the family maintain its purposes. They were committed to each other's happiness.

4. Expressed appreciation.

All these families could readily express appreciation and love to each other. Admiring the worth of each individual, it did not take a special occasion to speak their love.

5. Spiritually devout.

Each of these families tended to be religious. A time of trouble would draw the family together as they relied one ach other's resources to see them through. They learned that blessings could come from buffetings if they endured. So they did.
