“REFLECT THE LIGHT OF THE SON”

Sadly, some darken the light in their lives by sin. There is not a sin that will enter into Heaven, Revelation 21:27. In fact, sin is the transgression of the law, I John 3:4. James 2:10 teaches us, “For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.” Any sin can keep us out of Heaven, and send us to Hell. Sin brings darkness into our lives. Only God’s Word can bring us out darkness. Psalm 119:105 is where the Psalmist says to God, “Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.” The Old Law is nailed to the cross, Colossians 2:14. We are now under the New Law, James 1:27. Unless we are walking in the Light of God’s Son, then we are stumbling in the dark. Do not allow the wickedness of Satan to darken the Light of God’s Word in your life.

Think about the fact that we must not allow any of our words, thoughts, or actions to darken the light in our lives. Think about the sun and the moon. The moon reflects the light of the sun, and so we should reflect the Light of the Son of God, Christ, in our lives. We should be like the moon to the sun. Jesus says in Matthew 5:14-16, “Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”

You know, it just takes one sin in our life that we are unwilling to give up that people see that can keep us from leading others to Christ. You might think of it as little, but it will darken your influence. Think about the moon and sun again. The moon is so much smaller than the sun, but yet, it can still darken it from our vantage point on the earth during a solar eclipse and so too, you might think you have just one sin, and that you do not commit a lot of sins or sins such as murder, but any sin can keep you out of Heaven. You must give it up. We should aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Hebrews 12:1 says. We should do as the Psalmist says in Psalm 119:128, and say to God, “Therefore I esteem all thy precepts concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way.” We should abstain from all appearance of evil, I Thessalonians 5:22. We should not be a stumblingblock unto others by showing forth darkness, rather than light in our lives.

If we have sin in our lives, we should get out of it. Treat your body as the temple of the Holy Spirit. I Corinthians 3:16-17 says, “Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.” Take care of your body. Alcohol for pleasure purposes, tobacco, cigarette, and other drug use are sins that must be given up for God.

Live for God! Live for Him every day! Love Him! Reflect the Light of His Son in your life!
