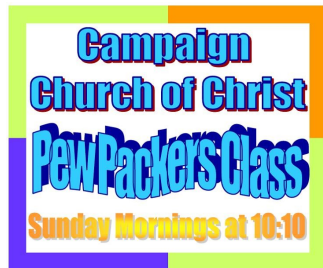

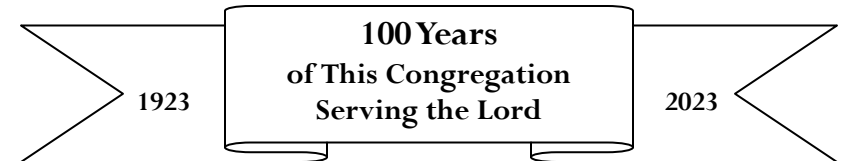

Looking back can be a good thing. There are various reason to look back. God has blessed us with memories to do so.

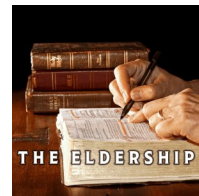
It is good to look back to the past to learn the good examples to be like them and to learn from the bad examples to not be like them. I Corinthians 10:11 says, “Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.” Let us look back to these examples.
