Revelation 1:3 states, "Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand." Here we find a blessing pronounced upon both the hearers and listeners of the prophecy of this great book of Revelation. The principle is laid forth that all who would read and hear the reading of the Holy Scriptures would be blessed. You see, the Word of God is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, and for instruction in righteousness. The Holy Scriptures equip us for every good work (II Timothy 3:16-17). We would do well to give our attention to them and read them every day, meditating upon them day and night (II Timothy 2:15, Psalm 1, I Timothy 4:13).
