### "WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A CHRISTIAN FORSAKES WORSHIP?" BY: TED KNIGHT

The following tragic consequences occur when a Christian deliberately forsakes the assemblies of the church:

- (1) Despite what you may tell yourself and others, your example shows that God and Christ are not first in your life.
- (2) You claim to be like Christ, but there is one way you are unlike him. He loved the church enough to die for it. You don't love it enough to sacrifice anything so that you might attend its services.
- (3) You tear down all the teaching of the new converts and become a poor example for them to follow. If they get to heaven some day, it will be in spite of you and not because of you.
- (4) You disappoint Jesus, who is present every time two or three gather in His name. He knows you aren't there, and He also knows why you are not there.
- (5) You leave no doubt in the minds of your faithful brethren that there are other things you enjoy more than worship and that there are earthly pleasures you prefer more than Christian fellowship.
- (6) You weaken your soul, put yourself on the side of Satan, hurt the church, discourage the preaching of the Word, and make it impossible to teach your children and neighbors how important the church is.
- (7) You disobey a plain command of God: "Not forsaking the assembling of yourselves together..." (Heb. 10:25). Can your neighbors willfully disobey the command to be baptized and be saved? If not, by what rule of logic can you willfully disobey the command to assemble and still expect to be saved?
