"EVERY MEMBER DOING HIS PART 1" BY: WINDELL GANN

The Lord's church is pictured for us in the New Testament under several different figures. It is an army, a temple, and even a bride. But a favorite figure portrays God's church as a spiritual body. Christ is the head in this figure (Col. 1:18) and the singleness of unity of the body is important, "For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ" (1 Cor. 12:12).

Just as one verse stresses the unity of the body, the next verse may be emphasizing the diversity of the body members and the important contribution each makes to the function of the body (Rom. 12:4-8; 1 Cor. 12:12-27; Eph. 4:4; 15-16). As one begins to grasp the composition and intricate systems of the human body, he appreciates the spiritual points being taught by the Holy Spirit.

Lessons from the Human Body

First, the physical frame and the faculties of the human body are indeed astounding. Nothing so complex and complete could result from mere chance. Even an uninspired man must stop and take note of man's sublime being.

Our appreciation for God's handiwork in the creation of our physical bodies can then be extended to the spiritual body which is His church. Man is made ever more aware of the importance of each aspect of his physical body as medical science advances and in like manner our love and appreciation of the Lord's church and every member of it grows as we study His Word.

One Mind Controls All Members

All actions that our bodies make are caused by electric impulses from the central nervous system to our muscles. These impulses are controlled in such a way that coordination of movement is made possible. One can gain an even better appreciation for this process by observing someone who cannot control his actions due to a disorder of the nervous system or who has lost his ability to use a limb altogether due to a severed nerve. Since Christ is the head, the body (the church) should move at His impulse.

Christ's prayer that we "may all be one" will not be attained by conforming to one another's point of view as are the attempts made today, but can only result when all are controlled by the directions of Christ.
