Each Member Has a Function

The Lord wants each member to realize his importance to the body. It is essential for us to know this so we can fully bear our responsibility. One should carefully read 1 Corinthians 12:14-27. Perhaps a part of our problem in losing so many members from the body of Christ is the feeling of insignificance shared by many members. Too many members (parts of the body) fail to realize their importance.

Paul says in verses 15-24 that the foot has its function; the ear, the eye, and all the internal hidden members have their functions. Each is important and the body cannot survive unless all the functions are carried out. Each Christian in the Lord's church today needs to be aware of his place. What contribution each can make, though it may seem insignificant, is important and necessary. We are realizing today there are no vestigial members of the physical body and this spiritual truth now needs to be learned.

Every Member Has a Contribution for the Body

The background of the passage in Ephesians 4:15-16 has to do with spiritual gifts the various members possessed, but the application is true today with regard to the natural contributions each member can make to the body of Christ: “From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.”

The Lord referred to His disciples as the salt of the earth and light of the world. God has entrusted these with His message. These are descriptions of the typical member of the body, not just the preachers or the elders! We cannot leave our function to others.

Conclusion

Have you buried your potential for service as did the one talent man? Have you deceived yourself into thinking attendance at your spiritual feeding time (worship) is your only function as a member? Considering your present activity would your absence from the body be felt or would you have to be replaced if you had to leave? Are you doing nothing because you do not have the ability to do some specific task that another member can do?

Can you claim to be putting the kingdom first (Mat. 6:33) while you take time to accomplish various secular tasks but fail to accomplish anything for the Lord? Every member of the body is a functioning member. Every member is important. Have you found your function? Are you performing it?
