## “SPREADERS AND HEARERS OF THE GOSPEL”

We need spreaders of the Gospel. We need hearers of the Gospel. Both are very important, and spreaders must be hearers and hearers must be spreaders.

**WE MUST SPREAD THE GOSPEL.** A great Christian in the New Testament of which we read about is Paul, an Apostle of our Lord Jesus Christ, and a faithful Follower of the Messiah. He was always ready to preach the Gospel, always ready to spread God’s Word. Likewise, we ought to always be ready to spread His Word. This is the Great Commission that has been committed or given unto us to spread God’s Word and convert as many as we can to bring people’s lives in harmony with the Creator’s Will and to help as many as we can go to eternal Heaven, rather than be lost in the eternal Hell (Matthew 28:18-20, II Timothy 4:2, Matthew 25:46, II Thessalonians 1:7-10). Paul says by inspiration of God in Romans 1:15-16, “So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.”

**WE MUST HEAR THE GOSPEL.** In considering these points, it is also very important that we are ready to listen to God’s Word being proclaimed. We ought to study His Word every day. Psalm 1:1-3 teaches, “Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.” We must study. II Timothy 2:15 reveals, “Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.” We ought to “. . . give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.” We know that, “. . . faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17).” Christ says in John 8:47, ‘He that is of God **heareth** God’s words: ye therefore **hear** them not, because ye are not of God.’

**THE BLESSINGS OF SPREADING AND HEARING.** Through obedience to the Gospel, we can have the best life here and the best life in eternity. Remember, Christ “. . . became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that **obey him**; (Hebrews 5:9).” We have so many blessings in Christ, which make our lives here truly abundant and successful. Some of these include the forgiveness of sins, Ephesians 1:7; the hope of Heaven, Titus 1:2; having Jesus and the Holy Spirit as our Intercessors, Romans 8:26 and 34; having God living within us, II Corinthians 6:16; having spiritual brothers and sisters along with their fellowship, I John 1:7; the ability to pray to God and have our prayers heard, I Peter 3:12; and Heaven in the end, Ephesians 1:11. *(Note: Continued on Page 4)*
