“SEEKING THE TRUTH”

Seek the Truth is necessary to know the Truth. Christ says in Matthew 7:7-8, “Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.” Those who want to know the Truth will know the Truth. Christ identifies the Word of God as Truth for us in John 17:17, when He prays to the Father, “Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.”

God’s specific providence also involves Him working to help those who are seeking out the truth, including those who may have not found the truth yet. I Peter 3:12 says, “For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.” Proverbs 28:9 says, “He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination.” God does not hear the prayers of the unfaithful with the intent to grant their requests, with one exception. If their request is to know what to do to be saved, He will grant this request of enabling them a way to where they can know the truth and thereby hear it and obey it, Romans 10:17. God does not save anyone by a sinner’s prayer, obedience must be involved. We learn from Acts 10, that Cornelius was, “A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God always,” Acts 10:2. We learn from verse 4 that his prayers were heard by God in that Cornelius was asking to know what to do to be saved. Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God. Cornelius was not saved until he was told what to do to be saved and was baptized, according to Acts 10:48 and Acts 11:14.

If one wants to know the truth, no matter if he be in the remotest jungle of Africa, God will providentially provide the way whereby he can hear the Gospel and know what to do to be saved. Jesus gave us His word on this when He said in Matthew 5:6, “Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.” In Philemon, we are told of a slave named Onesimus, who belonged to Philemon. Onesimus ran away from Philemon and encountered Paul. Paul spoke to him the Gospel and he obeyed it. Paul recognized that providence could have been involved in this. Paul says in verses 15 and 16 to Philemon, “For perhaps he therefore departed for a season, that thou shouldest receive him for ever; Not now as a servant, but above a servant, a brother beloved, specially to me, but how much more unto thee, both in the flesh, and in the Lord?” This literally means that Onesimus was parted for a season, which may denote the hidden action of God as an agent responsible for influencing what was done. God provided a way whereby Onesimus could know the truth and obey it. God’s specific providence then involves Him helping people who want to know the truth to receive it.
